Introduction to PASDEL

Since the Rio Earth Summit (UN Conference on Environment and Development), 1992, the concept of **sustainable development** is well recognized and is intended to be integrated as a cross-cutting issue at global and local levels. To reach those ambitious goals and, above all, to transform this concept into concrete actions, it is essential to offer **public and private actors, students, unemployed people and workers, specific training through innovative and practical tools, targeted to their needs.**

PASDEL: Practicing Sustainable Development through E-learning, under the European program Leonardo Da Vinci aims to achieve that goal at European level, especially in new member states.

This 2 year pilot project (from October 2006 to October 2008) associates **10 partners** from **7 European countries** working together to **build e-learning modules in four European languages** to tackle priority environmental issues in the five partner countries where the modules will be offered. The modules will be based on a common structure and on the pioneer experience of the "Academy of Sustainable and Human Development" in France (ADDH).

Objectives

- To involve local actors of different sectors in writing and testing of modules for the **best transferability at local level**;
- To improve the capacity of **public and private organizations** to integrate sustainable development aspects in all levels of decision-making;
- To facilitate the widest access to potential users: **university students, NGO's and business managers local government officials...**

How?

PASDEL is innovating e-learning by **sharing expertise to develop e-learning modules** on various themes in the field of **sustainable development**.

The e-learning modules will be developed in 5 countries: **Romania, Poland, Czech Republic, France and Belgium** (Walloon Region), on the themes defined as their priorities:

- **Sustainable development in private companies:** available in all countries
- **Green architecture in buildings:** Czech Republic, France and Belgium
- **Transports:** Czech Republic, France and Poland
- **Waste:** France, Poland and Romania
- **Local Agenda 21:** Belgium, France and Romania

For whom?

The e-learning training modules are developed for various target audiences defined in each country: employees of the governmental, non-governmental and business sectors, university students...

Results

- **In May 2008, an online training platform of e-learning modules on sustainable development themes** available in 4 European languages for the various target groups (individual and groups, private and public sectors);
- **a European network of actors of private and public sectors** which will use, implement and disseminate the work of PASDEL.
